#### Attendance at school

It is a legal requirement that all children enrolled in school attend every day with the exception of illness. <u>Health Care updates</u> – If your child has a health condition, it may be time to update your action plan or ASCIA details with us. If your child has a new health condition, please let us know so we can update these in your child's file.

We ask you not to pack nut products in your children's lunch boxes or bring in food containing nut products as we have children at the school with serious allergies and are at risk for anaphylaxis reactions.

<u>New parents please note</u>; we need a copy of your Drivers licence and 3<sup>rd</sup> Party insurance as well as WWCC to assist with school excursions using private transport. It's best to do this early in the year.

#### NATIONAL RIDE2SCHOOL DAY

Walk, bike ride, skate or scooter to school on March  $13^{\rm th}$ , to celebrate active travel.



Children under 16 years of age (and adults supervising them) are allowed to ride on a footpath in NSW.

Encourage your kids to follow these tips for safer riding:

- Always wear an approved bicycle helmet, properly fitted and fastened.
- Always obey road rules, including traffic lights, stop signs and give way signs.
- Turn your head when passing driveways
- Keep left when riding on the footpath and give way to pedestrians
- Travel at a speed that is safe for you and others
- Wear bright clothing to make yourself visible
